- Better use of existing structures in the EU member states (ERAMore/Euraxess)
- Strengthening information channels, training and cooperation (networking, sustainable resources)
- Institutionalisation of Mobility Centres
- Encourage universities to take responsibility for
 - all members of academic staff (permanent, temporary, mobile etc.), as *university mission!*
 - (legal framework) as an employer!
