- ECTS used as a tool for measuring a doctoral candidate workload to achieve <u>all learning outcomes</u> (LO) (expected from the courses taught, skills training and original research)
- B. ECTS used as a tool for measuring a doctoral candidate workload to achieve learning outcomes (LO) expected from the courses taught and skills training only
- c. No introduction of ECTS for doctoral programmes
